DONOR PRIVACY POLICY

The William & Mary Foundation respects the privacy of all donors. The William & Mary Foundation uses its best efforts to safeguard personal information and has policies and procedures in place to protect donor privacy for both online and offline donors.

Use of Personal Donor Data

Individual donor information is used by the William & Mary Foundation for University-related purposes only. Personal information that you submit to the Foundation will only be used to process the transaction(s) you request, for our internal use, and to contact you with regard to University events and information. Donors may request that their gifts be anonymous by contacting the Office of University Advancement.

Release of Information

On rare occasions, the Foundation may be legally required to disclose information. The William & Mary Foundation does not share, sell, rent, market or otherwise disclose individual donor information to any third party (such as contractors or vendors) for non-Foundation purposes, unless required by a court order, subpoena, or other legal/regulatory requirement.
